4. If each bar on a bar graph represents the preferences of 3 families for different types of Indian sweets, and you have a bar representing 15 families, how many types of Indian sweets would that bar represent?
5. If you made a pie chart to represent the distribution of preferred Indian spices in a group, and 25% of the chart represents cumin, how many people out of 20 prefer cumin?

## PROJECT (RESEARCH) WORK

**THEME:** CELEBRATING EARTH'S PHYSICAL AND HERITAGE DIVERSITY

**TOPIC:** DISCOVERING LANDFORMS AND HERITAGE SITES

**DESCRIPTION:** This project merges the study of Earth's major landforms with the exploration of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. By understanding the natural processes that shape our planet and appreciating the cultural and natural heritage of significant

locations, students will gain a comprehensive view of Earth's physical and cultural landscapes.

## METHODOLOGY:

### A: Imaginary Visit to a Heritage Location

- Imagine that you are visiting a heritage location in your assigned region. Write a short profile of the place in tabular form

Roll Number – 1 to 10 - North America - Grand Canyon National Park or Chichen Itza

Roll Number – 11 to 20 - South America - Machu Picchu or Iguazu National Park

Roll Number – 21 to 30 - Europe - Acropolis of Athens or Colosseum

Roll Number – 31 to 40 - Africa - Pyramids of Giza or Great Zimbabwe National Monument

Roll Number – 41 and above - Australia and Oceania – Kakadu National Park or Sydney Opera House

### B: Research and Presentation

Create a detailed project presentation your findings. This should include:

- a. A detailed description of the major landform found in the allocated area
  - Research and describe a major landform in your assigned region.
  - List few features of that landform
  - How is this landform affecting climate of that region?
  - What types of plants and animals live in that region?

- b. Information about the UNESCO World Heritage Site –
    - Name of the Heritage Site
    - Date on which UNESCO has declared it as a world heritage site.
    - Investigate and explain why the selected heritage site is under threat. This could include natural disaster, climate change, human activities, or other factors
    - Description of what makes the site unique and worthy of UNESCO recognition

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
- List the measures taken to preserve and conserve the heritage site. Include efforts by local communities, State government, national and international organization



### TASK: MODEL MAKING

Make a working /non-working model on the topic allotted to you as per your roll number. Be ready to explain the functioning and mechanism of your model after the vacations.

1. Periscope (Roll Number 1-4)
  - Build a working periscope to demonstrate the reflection of light.
2. Magnet-Powered Vehicles (Roll number 5-8)
  - Design a simple vehicle model that moves using magnetic repulsion or attraction.
3. String Telephone (Roll Number 9-12)
  - Make a simple string telephone to explain how sound waves can travel through a string.
4. Human Skeleton (Roll Number 13-16)
  - Build a model of the human skeleton using recyclable materials, highlighting major bones.
5. Rainwater Harvesting System (Roll Number 17-20)
  - Build a model demonstrating how rainwater can be collected and used, promoting water conservation.

6. Volcano Model (Roll Number 21-24)
    - Construct an erupting volcano model to demonstrate volcanic activity.
  7. Hydroelectric dam (Roll Number 25-28)
    - Build a model to show how water is used to generate electricity.
  8. Soil Formation (Weathering) (Roll Number 29-32)
    - Create a model that demonstrates how soil is formed.
  9. Satellite Orbits (Roll Number 33-36)
    - Construct a model showing how satellites orbit the Earth and Mention their uses.
  10. Renewable Energy (Roll Number 37-38)
    - Construct a model of a wind turbine or solar panel to demonstrate how it is used to generate electricity.
  11. Solar-Powered House (Roll Number 39-42)
    - Build a model of a house equipped with solar panels and mention the importance of using solar energy.
  12. Air Pollution and Its Solutions (Roll Number 43-46)
    - Objective: Demonstrate the causes and effects of air pollution and illustrate potential solutions with the help of a model.
