CBSE Class XII Physical Education (048) Exam Analysis

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) Class 12 Physical Education paper on **Monday, February 17, 2025** was moderate. There were inference based questions in some sections of the paper. Overall the questions were from the prescribed syllabus.

The **Physical Education** exam was for **70 marks**, to be attempted within 3 hours. The paper was divided into Section A, Section B, Section C, Section D & Section E

All the five sections in the paper were moderate. Students who have studied properly were able to solve it in an effective way. In Section A the MCQs were easy and direct.

In Section B questions were comprehensible where choices were given for the benefit of the students. Most students should have been able to tackle the short-answer questions effectively.

In Section C long answer questions were considered to be somewhat tough and tricky according to the students. In all the sets, these questions were a bit twisted and were based on inference. Long questions were of higher order thinking.

Sections D and E were comparatively lengthy. The language of the questions was direct in nature, which made it easy for the students to understand the demands of the questions.

The exam was neither too difficult nor too simple; it was designed with a moderate level of challenge, featuring questions that assessed the student's proficiency. Overall, the paper comprehensively covered various aspects of the subject.
